

Recognition for Outstanding Senior Students

College of Agriculture

Two awards: One given to the outstanding senior male student and one to the outstanding senior female student.

Eligibility:

- A student enrolled in the College of Agriculture who has earned 92 or more hours toward the B.S. degree, with a minimum of 60 hours earned at LSU-BR.
- Student must be scheduled to graduate within the current calendar year.

Selection criteria:

- Actively involved in professional and other activities in the College of Agriculture.
- Compiled an academic record demonstrating a commitment to academic attainment.
- Stated a clear career goal in a profession related to Agriculture.
- Committed to attending the ASA Banquet to accept the award.

Nominations:

- Individuals can be nominated by departments/schools, faculty, organization, peers, or self-nominated.
- To be considered, nominee must complete the application form by the established due date.

Recognition

- Each student will receive a cash stipend, provided by the College of Agriculture Alumni Association.
- A plaque with the names of winners will be permanently displayed in the College of Agriculture.
