CLASS RULES AND CROSS ENTRY

Walk-Trot (WT): Open to beginner junior and amateur riders who have never jumped at any horse shows. Halt and back may be asked. If this is the first division entered, cross entry into both walk pole-trot X and WTC is allowed.

Walk pole, trot X: open to beginner junior and amateur riders who have never jumped higher than 18" at any horse show. X's to be set at 12". Cross entry into WT and WTC allowed, but not mini stirrup.

Walk-Trot-Canter (WTC): same rules as Walk pole-trot X apply, except that if this is the first division entered, cross entry is allowed into mini stirrup only.

Child/Adult Mini Stirrup: open to beginner and amateur riders who have not jumped higher than 2' at any horse shows. Cross entry only into WTC.

Short & Long Stirrup: open to junior and amateur riders who have not jumped higher than 2'3" at any horse show. Cross entry into Novice equitation and Greenie Hunter allowed if this is the first division entered.

Greenie Hunter: open to all horses who are in their first year of showing. Rider may cross enter into any other division that they are eligible (except classes 1-15), including Novice, Limit, and Mini Jumper. Horses may show in any other classes in which they are eligible.

Novice Equitation: open to all juniors and amateurs who have never won more than 3 blue ribbons over fences 2'3" or higher. If this is the first division entered, the rider can cross enter into Limit and Mini Jumper.

Limit Equitation: open to all juniors and amateurs who have not won 3 blue ribbons over fences 2'6" or higher. Cross entry into Novice and Mini Jumper allowed.

Mini Jumper: open to all horses and riders.
