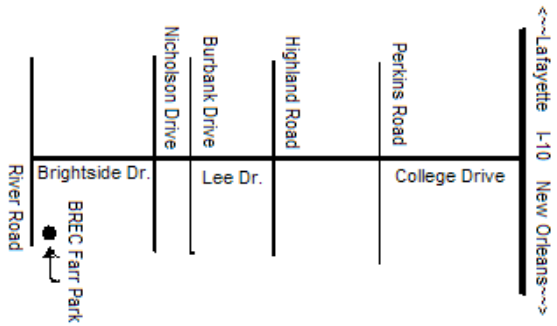

DIVISION RULES

Walk-Trot Equitation: Open to all beginner riders who have not jumped 2' or higher in classes at any show. Halt and back may be asked. Rider may cross enter into Beginner Eq. and Walk Trot Canter only. LHJA.

Beginner Equitation: Same rules as Walk Trot X's to be set at 12". Riders may not cross enter into Mini Stirrup.

Walk Trot Canter: Open to all beginners who have not jumped 2' or higher at any show. Riders may cross enter into Mini Stirrup only. LHJA

Child/Adult Mini Stirrup: Open to all beginners who have not jumped 2' or higher at any show. Rider may cross enter into Walk Trot Canter only. Trot in, canter out both fence classes. Fences at 18". LHJA.

Short Stirrup Hunter & Equitation: Open to riders 12 and under who have not jumped higher than 2'3" at any show. Riders may cross enter into Pre-Child/Adult Hunter and Children's Hunter Pony if applicable. Fences 2'. LHJA.

Long Stirrup Hunter & Equitation: Open to riders 13 and older. Same as Short Stirrup Hunter & Eq. Fences 2'. LHJA.

Children's Pony Hunter: Smalls to jump 2', mediums 2'3", and larges 2'6". Open to all ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a junior rider. LHJA.

Pre-Child/Adult Hunter: Open to all junior and amateur riders who are not jumping 3' or higher at this horse show. Fences 2'3". LHJA.

Baby Green Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies who are in their first year of showing. Fences 2'6". LHJA.

Limit Equitation: Open to all non-professional riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons over fences 2'6" or higher. Fences 2'6". LHJA.

Modified Child/Adult Hunter: Open to all non-professional riders who are not jumping 3'3" or higher at this show. Fences 2'6"-2'9". LHJA.

Pre-Green Hunter: Open to all horses and ponies in their second year of showing who have not jumped 3'6" or higher at any horse show. Fences 3'. LHJA.

Children's Hunter: Open to all juniors. Horse/rider combination may not jump 3'3" or higher at this horse show. Fences 3'. LHJA.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to all amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may not jump 3'3" or higher at this horse show. Fences 3'. LHJA.

LHJA Medal: Open to all junior and amateur members of LHJA. Riders that have shown 3'6" to jump 3'6", riders who have shown 3' to jump 3'. LHJA.

Junior/Amateur Owner Hunter: Open to all junior and amateur riders. Riders may cross enter into Children's Hunter and Adult Amateur Hunter on a different horse. Fences 3'6". LHJA.

Hopeful Jumper: Open to any horse or pony that does not jump higher than 3'6" at this show. Fences Level 1, 2'9"-3'.

Low Schooling Jumper: Open to any horse or pony who does not jump higher than 3'6" at this horse show. Fences Level 1, 2'9"-3'. LHJA.

Child/Adult Jumper: Open to all junior and adult amateurs not restricted by any other division. Fences Level 3, 3'3"-3'6". LHJA.

High Point Rider/Reserve High Point Rider: To be awarded to the top two riders at the 2004 Tiger Classic.

High Point "Team"/ Reserve High Point "Team": To be awarded to the top two barns or "teams" whose riders accumulate the most points at the 2004 Tiger Classic, mimicking an IHSA competition.

Class 51. \$250 Gambler's Choice, Level 1-3, 2'9"-3'6"

Open to all horses and riders that have shown in at least two other jumper classes at the 2005 Tiger Classic. About 8-10 jumps (no combinations) will be set up to be jumped in either direction, and assigned a point value from 10-120 points according to difficulty. Each competitor has 45 seconds to jump as many jumps as he/she wishes. Each obstacle may only be jumped twice. Points will be awarded only if the obstacle has been jumped correctly. At the end of 45 seconds, exhibitors will be allowed to jump the joker fence worth 200 points. If the joker fence is knocked down, 200 points will be deducted from the final score. The winner will be the exhibitor with the most points earned. For complete rules, refer to USEF Article 2749.
